

SNOW PLOW POLICY

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PROGRESS NO. 351

ORDER OF PRIORITY

1. Primary grids – grid #675 and #771
2. School bus routes – as provided by the Living Sky School Division (any changes requested by drivers is to be approved by council)
3. Main access roads to occupied residences
4. Roads to other farm yard sites
5. Other developed road allowances

CUSTOM WORK

1. Side roads needed to be opened to grain bags (just road) - opened once for free
2. Bin yard – opened once for free
3. All other including driveways to be charged at a rate as set by council
4. Access to grain bags cleared at custom rates
5. No yards

Prior to any custom work – a waiver of liability is to be signed by the landowner.

OTHER

Ridging – to be done only with permission from the landowner (Councillor responsible for their division)

RESIDENTIAL PLOWING AND PRIVATE ROADS

Residents are responsible for clearing snow from private driveways. Snow from private driveways shall not be placed on the municipal roadway or shoulders. Do not plow snow from driveways onto or across municipal roads. Accidents and damages caused by snow piles placed in the roadway may result in liability to the property owner. If the snow needs to be cleared away with municipal equipment a charge to those responsible will apply and it may also result in a misdemeanor charge.

CONTACTS

In the case of a blocked road, including oilfield roads, councillors for that division MUST be notified before work has started. All parties will be notified of status and an estimated time in which the work will be done.
