BYLAW NO. 97-6

A BYLAW CONCERNING THE FARMING OF THE GRID ROAD ALLOWANCES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Progress #351, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this bylaw is to enable the council to restrict the cultivating, disking or any other farming method of the Grid Road allowances within the municipality.

2. No person shall farm the Grid Road Allowances in the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351.
3. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
4. This bylaw is to take effect on passing of this bylaw.
