## BYLAW NO. 97-7


A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES PURSUANT TO  
SECTION 206 (2)(C) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT 1989

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Progress #351 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
  - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act;
  - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Highway Traffic Act.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 40 kilometers per hour on that portion of a public highway described as follows:
 

All that portion of the grid road commencing North of the Northwest quarter of Section 23 Township 34 Range 25 West of the third meridian and North of the Northeast quarter of Section 22 Township 34 Range 25 West of the third meridian.
3. A sign indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
5. This bylaw shall take effect on the day that it is approved by the Highway Traffic Board, pursuant to subsection 206(3) of the Rural Municipality Act, 1989.
