

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PROGRESS NO. 351

BYLAW NO. 2006/ 10

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT OBSTRUCTIONS ADJACENT TO CERTAIN ROAD ALLOWANCES

The council of the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to "Obstructions Adjacent to Road Allowance".
2. In this bylaw:
  - a) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351;
  - b) "Road" means any road allowance with the municipality other than
    - i) a private road; or
    - ii) a provincial highway;
3. No person shall plant trees or shrubs or place stone, earth, gravel piles, portable structures, machinery or other objects on private property within:
  - a) ninety metres (approx. 295 feet) from the intersection of the center lines of any municipal road;
  - b) forty six metres (approx. 150 feet) for the center line of any municipal road.
4. Council may, by order, direct the owner of any private property upon which a tree or shrub has been planted, or a stone, earth or gravel pile, portable structure, machinery or other object has been placed in contravention of the provisions of Section 3 hereof to remove the same within reasonable period of time as determined by council.
5. Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 3 hereof is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
6. Bylaw No. 96-2 is hereby repealed.
