BYLAW NO 2014/16

A BYLAW TO MANAGE VEHICLE WEIGHTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall:
 - a) operate a motor vehicle in excess of 6,500 kgs. on;
 - b) TWP RD 362 (Grid 771) from the junction of Saskatchewan Highway No.
 - 31 east to the junction with RGE RD 3244.
- 2. The restrictions set out in sections 3 of this bylaw shall not apply to those vehicles described in section 3 of *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations*, 2010.
 - a) Weight signs "Maximum 6.5 T" shall be erected at the west and east junctions on the designated municipal road
- 3. (1) A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence.
 - (2) The penalty for breach of any provisions of this bylaw shall be those set out in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
