

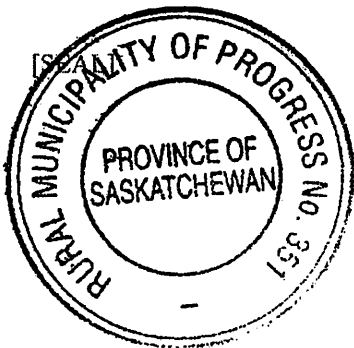
**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PROGRESS NO. 351**


**BYLAW NO 2014/16**

**A BYLAW TO MANAGE VEHICLE WEIGHTS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall:
  - a) operate a motor vehicle in excess of 6,500 kgs. on;
  - b) TWP RD 362 (Grid 771) from the junction of Saskatchewan Highway No. 31 east to the junction with RGE RD 3244.
  
2. The restrictions set out in sections 3 of this bylaw shall not apply to those vehicles described in section 3 of *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*.
  - a) Weight signs "Maximum 6.5 T" shall be erected at the west and east junctions on the designated municipal road
  
3. (1) A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence.  
(2) The penalty for breach of any provisions of this bylaw shall be those set out in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
