

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PROGRESS NO. 351
BYLAW NO. 05/2024

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 3-2017, known as the Zoning Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Progress No. 351, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 3-2017 as follows:

1. **Section 4.14 Setback from Centre Line of Roads** is amended by deleting subsection **4.14.1** in its entirety and replacing it with the following new subsection:

“4.14.1 The minimum setback of buildings, including dwellings, signs, trees and other permanent structures from the centre line of a municipal road allowance, grid road, main farm access road or provincial highway on all sites shall be 45 metres (150 feet). Power poles must be setback at least 30.5 metres (100 feet) from the centre line of such roads. Fences do not have a minimum setback from the centre line of such roads but must not be located within a road right of way. On provincial highways the minimum setbacks shall be regulated by the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure. Development of buildings on sites that do not abut such roads shall observe the minimum front yard setbacks as identified in the specific regulation for those districts.”

2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon being approved by the Minister of Government Relations.
